**SUBJECT:** SANITARY SEWER PROJECTS

Recently, City Council approved over \$600,000 of work to the existing sanitary sewer system in the City. Specifically, 1.3 miles of sanitary sewer pipe will be relined. The relining is intended to reduce inflow and infiltration into the sanitary sewer system. The segments of sewer pipe designated as being in the most critical condition have been prioritized for repair.

Beginning Friday, January 15, 2021, you will begin seeing workers and vehicles from Granite Inliner, LLC conducting preliminary inspections and staging for necessary repairs to the sewer pipe. The actual repair work is scheduled to begin in early to mid-February. The City of Gibraltar and the contractors will notify residents when work on segments of pipe near their homes will be started. You may receive a knock on your door from the contractor or an information tag when work on a particular segment will begin. You will also be informed in advance of any service interruptions during the repairs.
